# Winter School 2023 - Water Management and Food Security

# **Program outline**

The objective of the Winter School is to introduce important topics concerning the sustainable use and management of water resources under existing and emerging constraints, current situations in agricultural water management, food quality, and the value chain. The participants will be able to join group discussions to identify the current issues pertaining to water management and food security, as well as to draft innovative initiatives for sustainable supply of clean water and safe foods.

The program will be conducted in English, allowing you to freely practice English with international students, learn about new cultures, and make new friends.

#### **Dates and location**

The Winter School will be held from 19 to 25 February 2023 at the Vietnam National University of Agriculture (VNUA) in Hanoi, Vietnam.

#### Who can apply

Applicants should be enthusiastic, inquisitive, and eager to participate in English communication and the study topics. We will select around 10-15 participants for this Winter School.

# Expenses

The estimated expenses are as follows:

- International airfare from Shonai to Hanoi: ~100,000 120,000 JPY
- Accommodation: ~40,000 JPY
- Meals: ~600 JPY/day

The international airfare and accommodation costs will be covered up to 100,000 JPY, and students will be responsible for the remainder. Students are responsible for daily personal costs not covered by the program (food, local travel, etc.).
